- 1 AN ACT Relating to the transfer of cases from commissioners to 2 judges; and amending RCW 3.42.030.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 3.42.030 and 1984 c 258 s 32 are each amended to read 5 as follows:
- Any party may have a case transferred from a district court commissioner to a judge of the same district for hearing, by filing a
- 8 motion for transfer as long as the motion is filed and called to the
- 9 attention of the commissioner before any discretionary ruling has been
- 10 made. The following are not considered discretionary rulings: (1) The
- 11 arrangement of the calendar; (2) the setting of an action, motion, or
- 12 proceeding for hearing or trial; (3) the arraignment of the accused; or
- 13 (4) the fixing of bail. The commissioner shall forthwith transfer the
- 14 case to the judge.
