- 4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 88.02.040 and 1989 c 393 s 12 are each amended to read 5 as follows:
- 6 (1) The department shall provide for the issuance of vessel
- 7 registrations and may appoint agents for collecting fees and issuing
- 8 registration numbers and decals. Fees for vessel registrations
- 9 collected by the director shall be deposited in the general fund:

- 10 PROVIDED, That any amount above one million one hundred thousand
- 11 dollars per fiscal year shall be allocated to counties by the state
- 12 treasurer for boating safety/education and law enforcement programs.
- 13 Eligibility for such allocation shall be contingent upon approval of
