- 9 employee's or job applicant's substance abuse test results to a
- 10 prospective or current employer of that employee is presumed to be
- 11 acting in good faith and is immune from civil liability for such
- 12 disclosure or its consequences.
- NEW SECTION. Sec. 2. A new section is added to chapter 9.73 RCW
- 14 to read as follows:
- 15 This chapter does not apply to an employer who discloses
- 16 information about a former or current employee's or job applicant's
- 17 substance abuse test results to a prospective or current employer of
- 18 that employee. The disclosing employer is presumed to be acting in
