- 4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 29.07.152 and 1993 c 383 s 1 are each amended to read 5 as follows:

use to register to vote during the period beginning after the closing

- 8 of registration for voting at the polls under RCW 29.07.160 and ending
- 9 on the fifteenth day before a primary, special election, or general
- 10 election. During this period, ((the unregistered)) a qualified elector
