1 AN ACT Relating to off-campus disruptive behavior of higher 2 education students; adding a new section to chapter 28B.10 RCW; and 3 providing an effective date.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

5 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> Sec. 1. A new section is added to chapter 28B.10 RCW 6 to read as follows:

7 (1) All public institutions of higher education shall adopt rules
8 regarding disruptive off-campus conduct of students, including
9 sanctions.

10 (2) Sanctions may include, but are not limited to, counseling,11 probation, suspension, or expulsion.

(3) As used in this section, "disruptive off-campus conduct" means
all conduct resulting in a citation or conviction for the violation of
laws or ordinances that:

15 (a) Interferes with the institution of higher education's16 relationship with the surrounding community;

(b) Harms the reputation of the institution of higher education; or(c) Violates the institution of higher education's policies.

1 (4) Each public institution of higher education shall report the 2 substance of rules, including sanctions, to appropriate committees of 3 the legislature by December 1, 2000.

4 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> Sec. 2. If any provision of this act or its 5 application to any person or circumstance is held invalid, the 6 remainder of the act or the application of the provision to other 7 persons or circumstances is not affected.

8 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> Sec. 3. This act takes effect July 1, 2000.
