1 AN ACT Relating to changing penalties for juveniles who unlawfully 2 discharge a laser; amending RCW 9A.49.040; prescribing penalties; and 3 providing an effective date.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

5 Sec. 1. RCW 9A.49.040 and 1999 c 180 s 5 are each amended to read 6 as follows:

7 Unlawful discharge of a laser in the first degree ((or second degree is a civil infraction)) is a gross misdemeanor if committed by 8 a juvenile who has not before committed either ((offense)) <u>first or</u> 9 10 second degree unlawful discharge of a laser. Unlawful discharge of a laser in the second degree is a civil infraction if committed by a 11 juvenile who has not before committed either offense. The monetary 12 13 penalty imposed upon a juvenile for a civil infraction may not exceed 14 one hundred dollars.

15 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> Sec. 2. This act takes effect July 1, 2000, and 16 applies only to offenses committed on or after that date.
