1 AN ACT Relating to alternate operator services; and amending RCW
2 80.36.520.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 80.36.520 and 1988 c 91 s 2 are each amended to read
5 as follows:

6 The utilities and transportation commission shall by rule require,
7 at a minimum, that any telecommunications company, operating as or
8 contracting with an alternate operator services company, assure
9 appropriate disclosure to consumers of the provision and the rate,
10 charge or fee of services provided by an alternate operator services
11 company without requiring additional dialing by the consumer beyond
12 that necessary to complete a call.

13 For the purposes of this chapter, "alternate operator services
14 company" means a person providing a connection to intrastate or
15 interstate long-distance services from places including, but not
16 limited to, hotels, motels, hospitals, and customer-owned pay
17 telephones.
