- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 79.08 RCW 5 to read as follows:
- 6 Beginning with the 2001-03 biennial budget, the department of 7 natural resources shall include in its capital budget request to the governor a proposal to transfer ownership of trust property that cannot 8 be managed effectively for revenue production to recreation or 9 10 conservation status. Each biennium the department of natural resources shall establish one list of properties that are eligible for transfer 11 12 using criteria adopted by the board of natural resources. The criteria 13 shall include (1) land where the revenue generating capacity does not 14 justify the cost of management; (2) land on which revenue generating 15 capacity is constrained by state or federal law; and (3) land that is difficult to manage for revenue production because of significant 16 17 value, such as recreation, scenic considerations, conservation, or fish In identifying land in subsections (1) through 18 or wildlife habitat.

- 1 highest priority to land on islands with a sole source aquifer for the
- 2 purpose of enhancing aquifer recharge. The list of properties should
- 3 identify the appropriate public entity for receiving ownership of the
