- 1 AN ACT Relating to annexations by less than county-wide port
- 2 districts in areas having no registered voters; and amending RCW
- 3 53.04.150.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 5 **Sec. 1.** RCW 53.04.150 and 1999 c 250 s 2 are each amended to read 6 as follows:
- 7 A port district that is less than county-wide, and that is located
- 8 in a county with a population of less than ninety thousand and located
- 9 in <u>either</u> the Interstate 5 <u>or Interstate 90</u> corridor, may petition for
- 10 annexation of an area that is contiguous to its boundaries, is not
- 11 located within the boundaries of any other port district, and contains
- 12 no registered voters. The petition must be in writing, addressed to
- 13 and filed with the port commission, and signed by the owners of not
- 14 less than seventy-five percent of the property value in the area to be
- 15 annexed, according to the assessed value for general taxation. The
- 16 petition must contain a legal description of the property according to
- 17 government legal subdivisions or legal plats, or a sufficient metes and

- 1 bounds description, and must be accompanied by a plat outlining the
- 2 boundaries of the property to be annexed.
