- 17 shall be issued and sold upon the request of the Washington state

- (2) The department of transportation is authorized to spend no more than eighty million dollars per year on the repayment of any bonds issued under subsection (1) of this section.
- (3) These bonds are backed by the full faith and credit of the state of Washington, the motor fuel tax revenues, and by the allocation of federal funds as authorized by congress under the transportation efficiency act for the 21st century.
