1 AN ACT Relating to telecommunications and public benefit; amending 2 RCW 80.36.010; creating a new section; and declaring an emergency.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4 **sec. 1.** RCW 80.36.010 and 1985 c 450 s 15 are each amended to read 5 as follows:

(1) The right of eminent domain is hereby extended to all 6 telecommunications companies organized or doing business in this state. 7 (2) Prior to exercising the right of eminent domain, a 8 telecommunications company must submit to the county and to the 9 10 commission a written determination that addresses the public benefit the county will derive from its presence. The determination shall 11 include without limitation: 12 13 (a) The number of access points the telecommunications company will

14 provide to the county;

15 (b) The advanced telecommunications brought to the county by way of 16 the access points; and

17 <u>(c) Any other benefit.</u>

<u>NEW SECTION.</u> Sec. 2. Nothing in this act is intended to expand or
limit existing rights or obligations granted under the Washington state
Constitution.

4 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> Sec. 3. This act is necessary for the immediate 5 preservation of the public peace, health, or safety, or support of the 6 state government and its existing public institutions, and takes effect 7 immediately.
