1 TO THE HONORABLE WILLIAM J. CLINTON, PRESIDENT OF THE UNITED 2 STATES, AND TO THE PRESIDENT OF THE SENATE AND THE SPEAKER OF THE HOUSE 3 OF REPRESENTATIVES, AND TO THE SENATE AND HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF 4 THE UNITED STATES, IN CONGRESS ASSEMBLED:

8 WHEREAS, The federal tax reform act of 1986 put additional 9 financial stress on the taxpayers of the state of Washington by 10 eliminating the retail sales tax deduction; and

WHEREAS, Taxpayers in other states may deduct major state taxes in determining federal income tax; and

13 WHEREAS, Taxpayers of the state of Washington would realize 14 substantial reductions in federal tax burdens if they could deduct 15 retail sales taxes; and

16 WHEREAS, Congress is in the process of considering several 17 proposals for reducing federal revenues; and

18 WHEREAS, Congress could easily relieve the burden on taxpayers of 19 the state of Washington by restoring the full retail sales tax 20 deduction;
