- 1 BE IT RESOLVED, By the House of Representatives of the State of 2 Washington, the Senate concurring, That immediately before adjournment 3 SINE DIE of this 2000 1st Special Session of the Fifty-sixth 4 Legislature:
- 5 (1) The House of Representatives shall transmit to the Senate all Senate bills, Senate joint resolutions, Senate concurrent resolutions, 6 7 and Senate joint memorials in its possession that have not been passed by the House of Representatives, and upon receipt by the Senate of such 8 9 measures they shall be assigned to the Senate Rules Committee for third 10 reading; and
  - (2) The Senate shall transmit to the House of Representatives all House bills, House joint resolutions, House concurrent resolutions, and House joint memorials in its possession that have not been passed by the Senate, and upon receipt by the House of Representatives of such measures they shall be assigned to the House Rules Committee for third reading; and
- 17 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Co-Chief Clerks of the House of Representatives and the Secretary of the Senate shall retain in their 18 19 possession and in the status that exists upon the adjournment SINE DIE of the 2000 1st Special Session of the Fifty-sixth Legislature, all legislative measures including all bills, joint resolutions, concurrent

- 2 respective houses and all records, journals, dockets, and other
