WHEREAS, The Legislature concurs with the system of State Highways of Statewide Significance as designated by the Washington State Transportation Commission through Resolution 584 dated December 17, 4 1998;

NOW, THEREFORE, Your Memorialists respectfully pray that the Washington State Transportation Commission conduct a review of the system of State Highways of Statewide Significance and update the system as necessary at least every five years. This update process must include criteria that meet the legislative direction of RCW 47.06.140; must be carried out in consultation with the Regional Transportation Planning Organizations; and must provide ample opportunity for comment and due consideration of comments. As part of this update process, the Washington State Transportation Commission may adopt route additions and deletions from this designated system.
