- BE IT RESOLVED, BY THE SENATE AND HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON, IN LEGISLATIVE SESSION ASSEMBLED:
- 3 THAT, At the next general election to be held in this state the 4 secretary of state shall submit to the qualified voters of the state 5 for their approval and ratification, or rejection, an amendment to 6 Article VII of the Constitution of the state of Washington by adding a
- 7 new section to read as follows:
- 8 Article VII, section . . . Nothing in this Article VII as amended
- 9 shall prevent the legislature from providing, by appropriate
- 10 legislation, property tax relief by setting base years for property tax
- 11 valuation computation, limiting property tax valuation increases to two
- 12 percent per year over the base year until ownership of the property
- 13 changes, and limiting the tax assessed on owner-occupied property
- 14 claimed as a principal place of residence.
- 15 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the secretary of state shall cause
- 16 notice of this constitutional amendment to be published at least four
- 17 times during the four weeks next preceding the election in every legal
- 18 newspaper in the state.
