- 8 Article XXIX, section 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of
- 9 sections 5, and 7 of Article VIII and section 9 of Article XII or any
- 10 other section or article of the Constitution of the state of
- 11 Washington, the moneys of any public pension or retirement fund ((or)),
- 12 industrial insurance trust fund, or fund held in trust for the benefit
- 13 of persons with developmental disabilities may be invested as
- 14 authorized by law.
- 15 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the secretary of state shall cause
- 16 notice of this constitutional amendment to be published at least four
- 17 times during the four weeks next preceding the election in every legal
