1 (2) "Business or organization" means a business or organization 2 licensed in this state, any agency of the state, or other governmental 3 entity, that educates, trains, treats, supervises, houses, or provides 4 recreation to developmentally disabled persons, vulnerable adults, or 5 children under sixteen years of age, including but not limited to 6 public housing authorities, school districts, and educational service 7 districts.

- (3) "Civil adjudication" means a specific court finding of sexual abuse or exploitation or physical abuse in a dependency action under RCW 13.34.040 or in a domestic relations action under Title 26 RCW. In the case of vulnerable adults, civil adjudication means a specific court finding of abuse or financial exploitation in a protection proceeding under chapter 74.34 RCW. It does not include administrative proceedings. The term "civil adjudication" is further limited to court findings that identify as the perpetrator of the abuse a named individual, over the age of eighteen years, who was a party to the dependency or dissolution proceeding or was a respondent in a protection proceeding in which the finding was made and who contested the allegation of abuse or exploitation.
- (4) "Conviction record" means "conviction record" information as defined in RCW 10.97.030(3) relating to a crime against children or other persons committed by either an adult or a juvenile. It does not include a conviction for an offense that has been the subject of an expungement, pardon, annulment, certificate of rehabilitation, or other equivalent procedure based on a finding of the rehabilitation of the person convicted, or a conviction that has been the subject of a pardon, annulment, or other equivalent procedure based on a finding of innocence. It does include convictions for offenses for which the defendant received a deferred or suspended sentence, unless the record has been expunged according to law.
- (5) "Crime against children or other persons" means a conviction of any of the following offenses: Aggravated murder; first or second degree murder; first or second degree kidnaping; first, second, or third degree assault; first, second, or third degree assault of a child; first, second, or third degree rape; first, second, or third degree rape of a child; first or second degree robbery; first degree arson; first degree burglary; first or second degree manslaughter; first or second degree extortion; indecent liberties; incest; vehicular homicide; first degree promoting prostitution; communication with a

- 1 minor; unlawful imprisonment; simple assault; sexual exploitation of
- 2 minors; first or second degree criminal mistreatment; child abuse or
- 3 neglect as defined in RCW 26.44.020; first or second degree custodial
- 4 interference; <u>first or second degree custodial sexual misconduct;</u>
- 5 malicious harassment; first, second, or third degree child molestation;
- 6 first or second degree sexual misconduct with a minor; patronizing a
- 7 juvenile prostitute; child abandonment; promoting pornography; selling
- 8 or distributing erotic material to a minor; custodial assault;
- 9 violation of child abuse restraining order; child buying or selling;
- 10 prostitution; felony indecent exposure; criminal abandonment; or any of
- 11 these crimes as they may be renamed in the future.
- 12 (6) "Crimes relating to drugs" means a conviction of a crime to
- 13 manufacture, delivery, or possession with intent to manufacture or
- 14 deliver a controlled substance.
- 15 (7) "Crimes relating to financial exploitation" means a conviction
- 16 for first, second, or third degree extortion; first, second, or third
- 17 degree theft; first or second degree robbery; forgery; or any of these
- 18 crimes as they may be renamed in the future.
- 19 (8) "Disciplinary board final decision" means any final decision
- 20 issued by a disciplining authority under chapter 18.130 RCW or the
- 21 secretary of the department of health for the following businesses or
- 22 professions:
- 23 (a) Chiropractic;
- 24 (b) Dentistry;
- 25 (c) Dental hygiene;
- 26 (d) Massage;
- 27 (e) Midwifery;
- 28 (f) Naturopathy;
- 29 (g) Osteopathic medicine and surgery;
- 30 (h) Physical therapy;
- 31 (i) Physicians;
- 32 (j) Practical nursing;
- 33 (k) Registered nursing; and
- 34 (1) Psychology.
- 35 "Disciplinary board final decision," for real estate brokers and
- 36 salespersons, means any final decision issued by the director of the
- 37 department of licensing for real estate brokers and salespersons.
- 38 (9) "Unsupervised" means not in the presence of:

- 1 (a) Another employee or volunteer from the same business or 2 organization as the applicant; or
- 3 (b) Any relative or guardian of any of the children or 4 developmentally disabled persons or vulnerable adults to which the 5 applicant has access during the course of his or her employment or 6 involvement with the business or organization.
- 7 (10) "Vulnerable adult" means "vulnerable adult" as defined in 8 chapter 74.34 RCW, except that for the purposes of requesting and 9 receiving background checks pursuant to RCW 43.43.832, it shall also include adults of any age who lack the functional, mental, or physical ability to care for themselves.
- (11) "Financial exploitation" means the illegal or improper use of a vulnerable adult or that adult's resources for another person's profit or advantage.
- 15 (12) "Agency" means any person, firm, partnership, association, 16 corporation, or facility which receives, provides services to, houses 17 or otherwise cares for vulnerable adults.
- 18 **Sec. 6.** RCW 70.125.030 and 1996 c 123 s 6 are each amended to read 19 as follows:
- 20 As used in this chapter and unless the context indicates otherwise:
- 21 (1) "Core services" means treatment services for victims of sexual 22 assault including information and referral, crisis intervention, 23 medical advocacy, legal advocacy, support, and system coordination.
- 24 (2) "Department" means the department of community, trade, and 25 economic development.
- 26 (3) "Law enforcement agencies" means police and sheriff's 27 departments of this state.
- (4) "Personal representative" means a friend, relative, attorney, or employee or volunteer from a community sexual assault program or specialized treatment service provider.
- 31 (5) "Rape crisis center" means a community-based social service 32 agency which provides services to victims of sexual assault.
- 33 (6) "Community sexual assault program" means a community-based 34 social service agency that is qualified to provide and provides core 35 services to victims of sexual assault.
- 36 (7) "Sexual assault" means one or more of the following:
- 37 (a) Rape or rape of a child;
- 38 (b) Assault with intent to commit rape or rape of a child;

- 1 (c) Incest or indecent liberties;
- 2 (d) Child molestation;
- 3 (e) Sexual misconduct with a minor;
- 4 (f) <u>Custodial sexual misconduct;</u>
- 5 (q) Crimes with a sexual motivation; or
- 6 $((\frac{g}{g}))$ An attempt to commit any of the aforementioned 7 offenses.
- 8 (8) "Specialized services" means treatment services for victims of 9 sexual assault including support groups, therapy, specialized sexual 10 assault medical examination, and prevention education to potential
- 11 victims of sexual assault.
- 12 (9) "Victim" means any person who suffers physical and/or mental 13 anguish as a proximate result of a sexual assault.
- NEW SECTION. Sec. 7. A new section is added to chapter 72.09 RCW to read as follows:
- The department shall investigate any alleged violations of section
- 17 1 or 2 of this act that are alleged to have been committed by an
- 18 employee or contract personnel of the department, to determine whether
- 19 there is probable cause to believe that the allegation is true before
- 20 reporting the alleged violation to a prosecuting attorney.
