AN ACT Relating to funding the municipal research council; amending RCW 66.08.190 and 43.110.030; adding a new section to chapter 43.110 RCW; repealing RCW 43.88.114; providing an effective date; and declaring an emergency.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

6 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 43.110 RCW 7 to read as follows:

8 The city and town research services account is created in the state 9 treasury. Moneys in the account shall consist of amounts transferred 10 under RCW 66.08.190(2) and any other transfers or appropriations to the 11 account. Moneys in the account may be spent only after an 12 appropriation. Expenditures from the account may be used only for city 13 and town research.

Unobligated moneys remaining in the account at the end of the fiscal biennium shall be distributed by the treasurer to the incorporated cities and towns of the state under RCW 66.08.190(1)(b). The treasurer may disburse amounts appropriated to the municipal research council from the city and town research services account by warrant or check to the contracting parties on invoices or vouchers certified by the chair of the municipal research council or his or her
designee. Payments to public agencies may be made in advance of actual
work contracted for, at the discretion of the council.

4 **Sec. 2.** RCW 66.08.190 and 1995 c 159 s 1 are each amended to read 5 as follows:

6 <u>(1)</u> When excess funds are distributed, all moneys subject to 7 distribution shall be disbursed as follows:

8 (((1))) <u>(a)</u> Three-tenths of one percent to border areas under RCW 9 66.08.195; and

10 (((2))) (b) From the amount remaining after distribution under (a) 11 of this subsection (((1) of this section)), fifty percent to the 12 general fund of the state, ten percent to the counties of the state, 13 and forty percent to the incorporated cities and towns of the state. 14 (2) During the months of July, October, January, and April of each

15 year, prior to disbursing the distribution to incorporated cities and towns under subsection (1)(b) of this section, the treasurer shall 16 deduct from that distribution an amount that, when combined with any 17 18 cash balance in the city and town research services account, will fund that quarter's allotments under RCW 43.88.110 from any legislative 19 appropriation from the city and town research services account. The 20 treasurer shall deposit the amount deducted into the city and town 21 22 research services account.

23 (3) The governor may notify and direct the state treasurer to 24 withhold the revenues to which the counties and cities are entitled 25 under this section if the counties or cities are found to be in 26 noncompliance pursuant to RCW 36.70A.340.

27 **Sec. 3.** RCW 43.110.030 and 1997 c 437 s 2 are each amended to read 28 as follows:

29 The municipal research council shall contract for the provision of municipal research and services to cities, towns, and counties. 30 31 Contracts for municipal research and services shall be made with state agencies, educational institutions, or private consulting firms, that 32 33 in the judgment of council members are qualified to provide such research and services. Contracts for staff support may be made with 34 35 state agencies, educational institutions, or private consulting firms that in the judgment of the council members are qualified to provide 36 37 such support.

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Municipal research and services shall consist of: (1) Studying and 1 2 researching city, town, and county government and issues relating to 3 city, town, and county government; (2) acquiring, preparing, and 4 distributing publications related to city, town, and county government 5 and issues relating to city, town, and county government; (3) providing educational conferences relating to city, town, and county government 6 7 and issues relating to city, town, and county government; and (4) 8 furnishing legal, technical, consultative, and field services to 9 cities, towns, and counties concerning planning, public health, utility 10 services, fire protection, law enforcement, public works, and other issues relating to city, town, and county government. Requests for 11 12 legal services by county officials shall be sent to the office of the 13 county prosecuting attorney. Responses by the municipal research 14 council to county requests for legal services shall be provided to the 15 requesting official and the county prosecuting attorney.

16 The activities, programs, and services of the municipal research 17 council shall be carried on((, and all expenditures shall be made,)) in 18 cooperation with ((the cities and towns of the state acting through the 19 board of directors of)) the association of Washington cities((, which 20 is recognized as their official agency or instrumentality,)) and ((in cooperation with counties of the state acting through)) the Washington 21 state association of counties. Services to cities and towns shall be 22 23 based upon the moneys appropriated to the municipal research council 24 ((under RCW 82.44.160)) from the city and town research services account under section 1 of this act. Services to counties shall be 25 26 based upon the moneys appropriated to the municipal research council from the county research services account under RCW 43.110.050. 27

28 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> Sec. 4. RCW 43.88.114 (Appropriations to municipal 29 research council from motor vehicle excise taxes not subject to 30 allotment) and 1997 c 437 s 5 & 1983 c 22 s 2 are each repealed.

31 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> Sec. 5. This act is necessary for the immediate 32 preservation of the public peace, health, or safety, or support of the 33 state government and its existing public institutions, and takes effect 34 July 1, 2000.

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
