- 6 Every invitation to bid on a contract that is expected to cost ((in

- 9 work of the state or a state agency or municipality as defined under

bidder to submit as part of the bid, or within one hour after the

- 13 published bid submittal time, the names of the subcontractors ((whose
- 14 subcontract amount is more than ten percent of the bid price)) with

- 17 the bid)) of heating, ventilation and air conditioning, plumbing as
- 18 described in chapter 18.106 RCW, and electrical as described in chapter

- 1 more than one subcontractor for each category of work identified,
- 2 unless subcontractors vary with bid alternates, in which case the
- 3 bidder must indicate which subcontractor will be used for which
- 4 <u>alternate</u>. Failure of the bidder to submit as part of the bid the
- 5 names of such subcontractors or to name itself to perform such work or
- 6 the naming of two or more subcontractors to perform the same work shall
- 7 render the bidder's bid nonresponsive and, therefore, void. The
- 8 requirement of this section to name the bidder's proposed heating,
- 9 <u>ventilation</u> and <u>air</u> <u>conditioning</u>, <u>plumbing</u>, <u>and</u> <u>electrical</u>
- 10 subcontractors applies only to proposed heating, ventilation and air
- 11 conditioning, plumbing, and electrical subcontractors who will contract
- 12 <u>directly with the general contractor submitting the bid to the public</u>
