- AN ACT Relating to public printing; and amending RCW 43.78.130 and 43.78.140.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 43.78.130 and 1965 c 8 s 43.78.130 are each amended to read as follows:
- 6 All printing, binding, and stationery work done for any state
- 7 agency, county, city, town, port district, or school district in this
- 8 state shall be done within the state, and all proposals, requests, or
- 9 invitations to submit bids, prices, or contracts thereon, and all
- 10 contracts for such work, shall so stipulate: PROVIDED, That whenever
- 11 it is established that any such work cannot be executed within the

state, or that the lowest charge for which it can be procured within

- 13 the state, exceeds the charge usually and customarily made to private
- 14 individuals and corporations for work of similar character and quality,
- 15 or that all bids for the work or any part thereof are excessive and not
- 16 reasonably competitive, the officers of any such public corporation may
- 17 have the work done outside the state.

1 **Sec. 2.** RCW 43.78.140 and 1965 c 8 s 43.78.140 are each amended to 2 read as follows:

3 No bill or claim for any such work shall be allowed by any officer 4 of a state agency or public corporation or be paid out of its funds, unless it appears that the work was executed within the state or that 5 the execution thereof within the state could not have been procured, or 6 7 procured at reasonable and competitive rates, and no action shall be maintained against such corporation or its officers upon any contract 8 for such work unless it is alleged and proved that the work was done 9 10 within the state or that the bids received therefor were unreasonable or not truly competitive. 11
