1 AN ACT Relating to eliminating motorcycle handlebar height
2 restrictions; and amending RCW 46.61.611.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 46.61.611 and 1967 c 232 s 6 are each amended to read
5 as follows:

6 No person shall operate on a public highway a motorcycle in which
7 the handlebars or grips are more than (~~fifteen~~) thirty inches higher
8 than the seat or saddle for the operator.
