1 AN ACT Relating to studded tires; adding a new section to chapter 2 46.04 RCW; and adding new sections to chapter 46.37 RCW.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 46.04 RCW 5 to read as follows:

6 "Lightweight stud" means a stud intended for installation and use 7 in a vehicle tire. As used in this title, this means a stud that is 8 recommended by the manufacturer of the tire for the type and size of 9 the tire and that:

(1) Weighs no more than 1.5 grams if the stud conforms to Tire Stud
Manufacturing Institute (TSMI) stud size 14 or less;

(2) Weighs no more than 2.3 grams if the stud conforms to TSMI studsize 15 or 16; or

(3) Weighs no more than 3.0 grams if the stud conforms to TSMI studsize 17 or larger.

16 A lightweight stud may contain any materials necessary to achieve 17 the lighter weight.

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<u>NEW SECTION.</u> sec. 2. A new section is added to chapter 46.37 RCW
 to read as follows:

3 Beginning January 1, 2000, a person offering to sell to a tire 4 dealer conducting business in the state of Washington, a metal flange or cleat intended for installation as a stud in a vehicle tire shall 5 certify that the studs are lightweight studs as defined in section 1 of 6 7 this act. Certification must be accomplished by clearly marking the boxes or containers used to ship and store studs with the designation 8 "lightweight." This section does not apply to tires or studs in a 9 10 wholesaler's existing inventory as of January 1, 2000.

11 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> Sec. 3. A new section is added to chapter 46.37 RCW 12 to read as follows:

Beginning July 1, 2001, a person may not sell a studded tire or sell a stud for installation in a tire unless the stud qualifies as a lightweight stud under section 1 of this act.
