Brief Title: Clarifying the recognition of concealed pistol permits from other states.

HB 1391 - DIGEST

(SUBSTITUTED FOR - SEE 1ST SUB)

Declares that a license from another jurisdiction is valid for purposes of this act only if: (1) The license is currently valid in that jurisdiction; and

- (2) the Washington state department of licensing, after consultation with the Washington state patrol, has adopted a rule identifying the jurisdiction as one that:
- (a) Has eligibility criteria for the issuance of a concealed pistol license that are at least as restrictive as those in RCW 9.41.070;
- (b) Has administrative procedures and practices for determining eligibility of applicants that are at least as comprehensive and accurate as those used in this state; and
- (c) Recognizes Washington state concealed pistol licenses as valid in that state or will recognize Washington licenses upon the department's identification of the jurisdiction under this subsection.
