HB 1505-S - DIGEST

(DIGEST OF PROPOSED 1ST SUBSTITUTE)

Provides that an absentee ballot may be counted only if the return identification envelope was signed by the date of the primary or election for which it was issued and was either returned before the close of the polls on the day of the primary or election for which it was issued or has a date of mailing by the date of the primary or election for which it was issued.
