Brief Description: Creating a committee to improve tribal relations.

SCR 8422-S.E - DIGEST

(AS OF SENATE 2ND READING 2/9/00)

Proposes that a joint select committee on legislative/tribal relations be established to review, study, and recommend how the legislature and tribes may develop more effective relationships and arrange for intergovernmental mechanisms in order to be able to work together on common interests and problems.

Requires that the committee shall present its report and recommendations to the legislature not later than December 1, 2000.

Provides that the committee shall terminate on December 15, 2000.
