17 The appropriations in this section are subject to the
18 following conditions and limitations and specified amounts are
19 provided solely for that activity:

20 (1) \$240,000 of the motor vehicle account--state appropriation
21 is provided solely for the completion of a study updating the
22 legislature on the freight and goods road systems on county roads.

23 (2) The appropriations contained in this section include
24 funding to assist counties in providing match for federal emergency
25 funding for earthquake damage as determined by the county road
26 administration board. The county road administration board shall
27 report to the transportation committees of the senate and house of
28 representatives and the office of financial management by September
29 30, 2001, on the projects selected to receive match funding.

11 The appropriations in this section are subject to the
12 following conditions and limitations and specified amounts are
13 provided solely for that activity:

14 (1) The transportation improvement account--state
15 appropriation includes \$60,000,000 in proceeds from the sale of
16 bonds, \$30,000,000 authorized by RCW 47.26.500, and \$30,000,000
17 authorized by House Bill No. 2788. If House Bill No. 2788 is not
18 enacted in the form passed by the legislature \$30,000,000 of the
19 amount provided in this subsection shall lapse.

20 (2) The appropriations contained in this section include
21 funding to assist cities and counties in providing match for
22 federal emergency funding for earthquake damage as determined by
23 the transportation improvement board. The transportation
24 improvement board shall report to the transportation committees of
25 the senate and house of representatives and the office of financial
26 management by September 30, 2001, on the projects selected to
27 receive match funding."

28 Renumber the remaining sections consecutively, correct any
29 internal references accordingly, and correct the title.

EFFECT: Authorizes the county road administration board and
the transportation improvement board to use appropriated funds to
provide matching funds enabling cities and counties to qualify for

federal emergency funding for earthquake damage.
