9 The person holding the office of county auditor, or deputy, or 10 performing its duties, shall not practice as an attorney or represent any person who is making any claim against the county, or who is 11 12 seeking to procure any legislative or other action by the board of 13 county commissioners. ((The county auditor, during his term of office, and any deputy appointed by him is disqualified from performing the 14 15 duties of any other county officer or acting as deputy for any other 16 county officer. Nor shall any other county officer or his deputy act as auditor or deputy, or perform any of the duties of said office.))" 17

18 Correct the title.

EFFECT: Strikes the underlying bill and removes the prohibition in existing law on county auditors and their deputies from performing the duties of any other county officer or his or her deputy; and removes the prohibition on any other county officer and his or her deputy from performing the duties of the county auditor or his or her deputy.
