If the juvenile offender is subject to a standard range disposition 14 of local sanctions or 15 to 36 weeks of confinement and has not 15 16 committed an A- or B+ offense, the court may impose a disposition under RCW 13.40.160(4) and 13.40.165. 17

# OPTION C MANIFEST INJUSTICE

OR

If the court determines that a disposition under option A or B would 21 effectuate a manifest injustice, the court shall impose a disposition 22 outside the standard range under RCW 13.40.160(2). 23

<u>NEW SECTION.</u> Sec. 4. The sentencing guidelines commission shall 24 study the impact of the sentencing changes in this act upon the 25 26 incidence of the crime of taking a motor vehicle without permission. 27 By December 2004, the commission shall submit a report to the governor and the legislature. The report shall address: 28

29 (1) Whether the creation of the crime of taking a motor vehicle 30 without permission in the first degree and the increased penalties for that new crime have resulted in a reduction in the number of 31 32 convictions for taking a motor vehicle without permission in the first 33 or second degree; and

(2) Whether there are other actions, either civil or criminal, that 34 could have the effect of further decreasing the incidence of these 35

1 crimes, including but not limited to: The revocation of driving 2 privileges, double scoring of prior convictions, or increasing 3 penalties for juveniles."
