- 9 (b) As a disciplinary measure for a reasonable period of time and 10 no permanent injury or illness resulted."

**EFFECT:** Adds affirmative defenses to the crime of criminal mistreatment in the fourth degree for religious observances and discipline where no permanent injury or illness resulted.
