7 "NEW SECTION. **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 43.34 RCW
8 to read as follows:

9 (1) The legislature shall approve names for new or existing
10 buildings on the state capitol grounds based upon recommendations from
11 the state capitol committee and the director of the department of
12 general administration, with the advice of the capitol campus design
13 advisory committee, subject to the following limitations:

14 (a) An existing building may be renamed only after a substantial
15 renovation or a change in the predominant tenant agency headquartered
16 in the building.

17 (b) A new or existing building may be named or renamed after:

18 (i) An individual who has played a significant role in Washington
19 history;

20 (ii) The purpose of the building;

21 (iii) The single or predominant tenant agency headquartered in the
22 building;

23 (iv) A significant place name or natural place in Washington;

24 (v) A Native American tribe located in Washington;

25 (vi) A group of people or type of person;

26 (vii) Any other appropriate person consistent with this section as
27 recommended by the director of the department of general
28 administration.

29 (c) The names on the facades of the state capitol group shall not
30 be removed.

31 (2) The legislature shall approve names for new or existing public
32 rooms or spaces on the west capitol campus based upon recommendations
33 from the state capitol committee and the director of the department of
34 general administration, with the advice of the capitol campus design
35 advisory committee, subject to the following limitations:

1 (a) An existing room or space may be renamed only after a
2 substantial renovation;

3 (b) A new or existing room or space may be named or renamed only
4 after:

5 (i) An individual who has played a significant role in Washington
6 history;

7 (ii) The purpose of the room or space;

8 (iii) A significant place name or natural place in Washington;

9 (iv) A Native American tribe located in Washington;

10 (v) A group of people or type of person;

11 (vi) Any other appropriate person consistent with this section as
12 recommended by the director of the department of general
13 administration.

14 (3) When naming or renaming buildings, rooms, and spaces under this
15 section, consideration must be given to: (a) Any disparity that exists
16 with respect to the gender of persons after whom buildings, rooms, and
17 spaces are named on the state capitol grounds; (b) the diversity of
18 human achievement; and (c) the diversity of the state's citizenry and
19 history. When naming or renaming a building, room, or space after a
20 person or a group significant in Washington history, it shall be after
21 the tenth anniversary of the person's death or death of the last
22 surviving member of the group.

23 (4) For purposes of this section, "state capitol grounds" means
24 buildings and land owned by the state and otherwise designated as state
25 capitol grounds, including the west capitol campus, the east capitol
26 campus, the north capitol campus, the Tumwater campus, the Lacey
27 campus, Sylvester Park, Centennial Park, the Old Capitol Building, and
28 Capitol Lake."
