7 "Sec. 1. RCW 28A.410.010 and 1992 c 159 s 3 and 1992 c 60 s 2 are
8 each reenacted and amended to read as follows:

9 The state board of education shall establish, publish, and enforce
10 rules and regulations determining eligibility for and certification of
11 personnel employed in the common schools of this state, including
12 certification for emergency or temporary, substitute or provisional
13 duty and under such certificates or permits as the board shall deem
14 proper or as otherwise prescribed by law. The rules shall require that
15 the initial application for certification shall require a record check
16 of the applicant through the Washington state patrol criminal
17 identification system and through the federal bureau of investigation
18 at the applicant's expense. The record check shall include a
19 fingerprint check using a complete Washington state criminal
20 identification fingerprint card. The superintendent of public
21 instruction may waive the record check for any applicant who has had a
22 record check within the two years before application. The rules shall
23 permit a holder of a lapsed certificate but not a revoked or suspended
24 certificate to be employed on a conditional basis by a school district
25 with the requirement that the holder must complete any certificate
26 renewal requirements established by the state board of education within
27 two years of initial reemployment.

28 In establishing rules pertaining to the qualifications of
29 instructors of American sign language the state board shall consult
30 with the national association of the deaf, "sign instructors guidance
31 network" (s.i.g.n.), and the Washington state association of the deaf
32 for evaluation and certification of sign language instructors.

33 The superintendent of public instruction shall act as the
34 administrator of any such rules and regulations and have the power to
35 issue any certificates or permits and revoke the same in accordance
36 with board rules and regulations."
