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5 Strike everything after the enacting clause and insert the
6 following:

7 "Sec. 1. RCW 39.35.060 and 1996 c 186 s 404 are each amended to
8 read as follows:

9 The department may impose fees upon affected public agencies for
10 the review of life-cycle cost analyses. The fees shall be deposited in
11 the ~~((energy efficiency services account established in RCW
12 39.35C.110))~~ general administration services account. The purpose of
13 the fees is to recover the costs by the department for review of the
14 analyses. The department shall set fees at a level necessary to
15 recover all of its costs related to increasing the energy efficiency of
16 state-supported new construction. The fees shall not exceed one-tenth
17 of one percent of the total cost of any project or exceed two thousand
18 dollars for any project unless mutually agreed to. The department
19 shall provide detailed calculation ensuring that the energy savings
20 resulting from its review of life-cycle cost analysis justify the costs
21 of performing that review.

22 **Sec. 2.** RCW 43.19.025 and 1998 c 105 s 1 are each amended to read
23 as follows:

24 The general ~~((services))~~ administration ~~((general administration
25 services))~~ services account is created in the custody of the state
26 treasurer and shall be used for all activities previously budgeted and
27 accounted for in the following internal service funds: The motor
28 transport account, the general administration management fund, the
29 general administration facilities and services revolving fund, the
30 central stores revolving fund, the surplus property purchase revolving
31 fund, ~~((and))~~ the risk management account, and the energy efficiency
32 services account. Only the director or the director's designee may
33 authorize expenditures from the account. The account is subject to the
34 allotment procedures under chapter 43.88 RCW, except for the cost of

1 goods sold in the office of procurement and the cost of postage in the
2 consolidated mail service.

3 **Sec. 3.** RCW 43.19.1923 and 1998 c 105 s 6 are each amended to read
4 as follows:

5 The general administration services account shall be used for the
6 purchase of supplies and equipment handled or rented through central
7 stores, and the payment of salaries, wages, and other costs incidental
8 to the acquisition, operation, and maintenance of the central stores,
9 and other activities connected therewith, which shall include utilities
10 services. ~~((Disbursements from the account for the purchasing and
11 contract administration activities of the division of purchasing within
12 the department are subject to appropriation and allotment procedures
13 under chapter 43.88 RCW. Disbursements for all other state purchasing
14 activities within the general administration services account are not
15 subject to appropriation.))~~ The account shall be credited with all
16 receipts from the rental, sale, or distribution of supplies, equipment,
17 and services rendered to the various state agencies. Central stores,
18 utilities services, and other activities within the general
19 administration services account shall be treated as separate operating
20 entities for financial and accounting control. Financial records
21 involving the general administration services account shall be designed
22 to provide data for achieving maximum effectiveness and economy of each
23 individual activity within the account.

24 **Sec. 4.** RCW 43.99I.020 and 1997 c 456 s 38 are each amended to
25 read as follows:

26 Bonds issued under RCW 43.99I.010 are subject to the following
27 conditions and limitations:

28 General obligation bonds of the state of Washington in the sum of
29 one billion two hundred seventy-one million sixty-five thousand
30 dollars, or so much thereof as may be required, shall be issued for the
31 purposes described and authorized by the legislature in the capital and
32 operating appropriations acts for the 1991-93 fiscal biennium and
33 subsequent fiscal biennia, and to provide for the administrative cost
34 of such projects, including costs of bond issuance and retirement,
35 salaries and related costs of officials and employees of the state,
36 costs of insurance or credit enhancement agreements, and other expenses
37 incidental to the administration of capital projects. Subject to such

1 changes as may be required in the appropriations acts, the proceeds
2 from the sale of the bonds issued for the purposes of this subsection
3 shall be deposited in the state building construction account created
4 by RCW 43.83.020 and transferred as follows:

5 (1) Eight hundred thirty-five thousand dollars to the state higher
6 education construction account created by RCW 28B.10.851;

7 (2) Eight hundred seventy-one million dollars to the state building
8 construction account created by RCW 43.83.020;

9 (3) Two million eight hundred thousand dollars to the ((~~energy~~
10 ~~efficiency services account created by RCW 39.35C.110~~)) general
11 administration services account for energy efficiency services;

12 (4) Two hundred fifty-five million five hundred thousand dollars to
13 the common school reimbursable construction account hereby created in
14 the state treasury;

15 (5) Ninety-eight million six hundred forty-eight thousand dollars
16 to the higher education reimbursable construction account hereby
17 created in the state treasury;

18 (6) Three million two hundred eighty-four thousand dollars to the
19 data processing building construction account created in RCW
20 43.99I.100; and

21 (7) Nine hundred thousand dollars to the Washington state dairy
22 products commission facility account created in RCW 43.99I.110.

23 These proceeds shall be used exclusively for the purposes specified
24 in this subsection, and for the payment of expenses incurred in the
25 issuance and sale of the bonds issued for the purposes of this section,
26 and shall be administered by the office of financial management,
27 subject to legislative appropriation.

28 NEW SECTION. Sec. 5. RCW 39.35C.110 (Energy efficiency services
29 account--Fees) and 1996 c 186 s 415 & 1991 c 201 s 12 are each
30 repealed."
