- 9 The application for  $((\frac{1}{4}))$  a certificate of ownership shall be 10 upon a form furnished or approved by the department and shall contain:
- 11 (1) A full description of the vehicle, which shall contain the 12 proper vehicle identification number, the number of miles indicated on 13 the odometer at the time of delivery of the vehicle, and any 14 distinguishing marks of identification;
- 15 (2) The name and address of the person who is to be the registered 16 owner of the vehicle and, if the vehicle is subject to a security 17 interest, the name and address of the secured party;
- (3) Such other information as the department may require. 18 The department may in any instance, in addition to the information required 19 20 on the application, require additional information and a physical examination of the vehicle or of any class of vehicles, or either. A 21 physical examination of the vehicle is mandatory if ((it previously was 22 23 registered in any other state or country or if)) it has been rebuilt after surrender of the certificate of ownership to the department under 24 25 RCW 46.12.070 due to the vehicle's destruction or declaration as a total loss. The inspection must verify that the vehicle identification 26 27 number is genuine and agrees with the number shown on the ((foreign)) 28 title and registration certificate. ((<del>If the vehicle is from a</del> jurisdiction that does not issue titles, the inspection must verify 29 30 that the vehicle identification number is genuine and agrees with the number shown on the registration certificate. The inspection must also 31 confirm that the license plates on the vehicle are those assigned to 32 the vehicle by the jurisdiction in which the vehicle was previously 33 34 licensed.)) The inspection must be made by a member of the Washington 35 state patrol or other person authorized by the department to make such 36 inspections.

- 1 The application shall be subscribed by the registered owner and be
- 2 sworn to by that applicant in the manner described by RCW 9A.72.085.
- 3 The department shall retain the application in either the original,
- 4 computer, or photostatic form.
- 5 **Sec. 2.** RCW 46.12.040 and 1990 c 238 s 2 are each amended to read 6 as follows:
- 7 The application accompanied by a draft, money order, certified bank
- 8 check, or cash for one dollar and twenty-five cents, together with the
- 9 last preceding certificates or other satisfactory evidence of
- 10 ownership, shall be forwarded to the director.
- 11 The fee shall be in addition to any other fee for the license
- 12 registration of the vehicle. The certificate of ownership shall not be
- 13 required to be renewed annually, or at any other time, except as by law
- 14 provided.
- In addition to the application fee and any other fee for the
- 16 license registration of a vehicle, ((there shall be collected from the
- 17 applicant an inspection fee whenever a physical examination of the
- 18 vehicle is required as a part of the vehicle licensing or titling

- 20 For vehicles previously registered in any other state or country,
- 21 the inspection)) the department shall collect from the applicant a fee
- 22 ((shall be)) of fifteen dollars ((and)) for vehicles previously
- 23 registered in any other state or country. The proceeds from the fee
- 24 shall be deposited in the motor vehicle fund. For ((all other))
- 25 vehicles requiring a physical examination, the inspection fee shall be
- 26 ((twenty)) fifty dollars and shall be deposited in the motor vehicle

- NEW SECTION. Sec. 3. A new section is added to chapter 46.12 RCW
- 29 to read as follows:
- The department shall institute software and systems modifications
- 31 to enable a WACIC/NCIC stolen vehicle search of out-of-state vehicles
- 32 as part of the title transaction. During the stolen vehicle search, if
- 33 the information obtained indicates the vehicle is stolen, that
- 34 information shall be immediately reported to the state patrol and the
- 35 applicant shall not be permitted to register the vehicle. Vehicles for
- 36 which the stolen vehicle check is negative shall be registered if the
- 37 department is satisfied that all other requirements have been met.

1 **Sec. 4.** RCW 46.12.060 and 1975 c 25 s 10 are each amended to read 2 as follows:

3 Before the department shall issue a certificate of ownership, or 4 reissue such a certificate, covering any vehicle, the identification number of which has been altered, removed, obliterated, defaced, 5 omitted, or is otherwise absent, the registered owner of the vehicle 6 7 shall file an application with the department, accompanied by a fee of 8 five dollars, upon a form provided, and containing such facts and 9 information as shall be required by the department for the assignment of a special number for such vehicle. 10 Upon receipt of such application, the department, if satisfied the applicant is entitled to 11 the assignment of an identification number, shall designate a special 12 identification number for such vehicle, which shall be noted upon the 13 14 application therefor, and likewise upon a suitable record of the authorization of the use thereof, to be kept by the department. 15 assigned identification number shall be placed or stamped in a 16 conspicuous position upon the vehicle in such manner and form as may be 17 prescribed by the department. Upon receipt by the department of ((a 18 19 certificate by an officer of the Washington state patrol, or other person authorized by the department, that the vehicle has been 20 inspected and that the identification number or the special number 21 plate, has been stamped or securely attached in a conspicuous position 22 upon the vehicle, accompanied by)) an application for a certificate of 23 24 ownership or application for reissue of such certificate and the 25 required fee therefor, the department shall use such number as the 26 numerical or alpha-numerical identification marks for the vehicle in any certificate of license registration or certificate of ownership 27 that may thereafter be issued therefor. 28

NEW SECTION. Sec. 5. This act is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, or safety, or support of the state government and its existing public institutions, and takes effect July 1, 2001."

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On page 1, line 1 of the title, after "registration;" strike the remainder of the title and insert "amending RCW 46.12.040 and 46.12.060; reenacting and amending RCW 46.12.030; adding a new section

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to chapter 46.12 RCW; providing an effective date; and declaring an

emergency."

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
