- 11 superintendent of public instruction shall monitor highly capable
- 12 programs at least once every five years. Monitoring shall begin during
- 13 the 2002-03 school year.
- 14 Any program review and monitoring under this section may be
- 15 conducted concurrently with other program reviews and monitoring
- 16 conducted by the office of the superintendent of public instruction.
- 17 In its review, the office shall monitor program components that include
- 18 but need not be limited to the process used by the district to identify
- 19 and reach out to highly capable students with diverse talents and from
- 20 diverse backgrounds, assessment data and other indicators to determine
- 21 how well the district is meeting the academic needs of highly capable
- 22 students, and district expenditures used to enrich or expand
- 23 opportunities for these students.
- 24 Beginning June 30, 2003, and every five years thereafter, the
- 25 office of the superintendent of public instruction shall submit a
- 26 report to the education committees of the house of representatives and
- 27 the senate that provides a brief description of the various
