- 5 Strike everything after the enacting clause and insert the
- 6 following:
- 7 "NEW SECTION. Sec. 1. (1) The legislature finds that the
- 8 legislation passed in 1997 that created a voluntary program authorizing
- 9 environmental excellence program agreements with persons regulated by
- 10 the environmental laws of Washington state was intended to provide
- 11 flexibility to the regulated community without adversely affecting the
- 12 state's environmental protection standards. However, the low number of
- 13 environmental excellence program agreements entered into since 1997 has
- 14 been disappointing.
- 15 (2) The legislature further finds that in light of the low
- 16 participation rates, and the development of similar programs in other
- 17 states since 1997, the environmental excellence program should be
- 18 evaluated in an effort to identify and eliminate current barriers that
- 19 are discouraging the execution of environmental excellence program
- 20 agreements.
- 21 (3) The authority for the department of ecology to enter into
- 22 environmental excellence program agreements terminates June 30, 2002.
- 23 The legislature finds that this date should be extended in order to
- 24 continue the environmental excellence program and to provide time for
- 25 the legislature to evaluate and act on any necessary changes to the
- 26 program that will encourage increased participation.
- 27 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 2.** A new section is added to chapter 43.21K RCW
- 28 to read as follows:
- 29 Citizens of the state of Washington have the right to expect the
- 30 following information to be provided to them when asking for a permit,
- 31 license, or permission to engage in a lawful activity:
- 32 (1) A date in time for a decision on permits;
- 33 (2) A defined amount of information required to award a permit by
- 34 a permitting authority before any application for permits can be
- 35 accepted; and

- 1 (3) An estimate of the maximum amount of costs in fees, studies, or public processes that will be incurred by the permit applicant.
- 3 This section does not create a right of action.
- 4 **Sec. 3.** RCW 43.21K.160 and 1997 c 381 s 19 are each amended to 5 read as follows:
- The authority of a director to enter into a new environmental excellence program agreement program shall be terminated June 30,
- 8 ((2002)) 2006. Environmental excellence program agreements entered
- 9 into before June 30, ((2002)) 2006, shall remain in force and effect
- 10 subject to the provisions of this chapter."
