- 8 WHAT CONSTITUTES FILING; EFFECTIVENESS OF FILING. (a) What
  9 constitutes filing. Except as otherwise provided in subsection (b) of
  10 this section, communication of a record to a filing office and tender
  11 of the filing fee or acceptance of the record by the filing office
- 13 (b) Refusal to accept record; filing does not occur. Filing does 14 not occur with respect to a record that a filing office refuses to 15 accept because:
- 16 (1) The record is not communicated by a method or medium of 17 communication authorized by the filing office;
- (2) An amount equal to or greater than the applicable filing fee is not tendered or, in the case of a filing office described in RCW 62A.9A-501(a)(1), an amount equal to the applicable filing fee is not
- 21 tendered;
- 22 (3) The filing office is unable to index the record because:
- 23 (A) In the case of an initial financing statement, the record does 24 not provide a name for the debtor;
- 25 (B) In the case of an amendment or correction statement, the 26 record:
- (i) Does not identify the initial financing statement as required by RCW 62A.9A-512 or 62A.9A-518, as applicable; or
- 29 (ii) Identifies an initial financing statement whose effectiveness 30 has lapsed under RCW 62A.9A-515;
- 31 (C) In the case of an initial financing statement that provides the 32 name of a debtor identified as an individual or an amendment that 33 provides a name of a debtor identified as an individual which was not 34 previously provided in the financing statement to which the record 35 relates, the record does not identify the debtor's last name; or

- 1 (D) In the case of a record filed or recorded in the filing office 2 described in RCW 62A.9A-501(a)(1), the record does not provide a <u>name</u> 3 <u>for the debtor or a sufficient description of the real property to</u> 4 which ((it)) <u>the record</u> relates;
- 5 (4) In the case of an initial financing statement or an amendment 6 that adds a secured party of record, the record does not provide a name 7 and mailing address for the secured party of record;
- 8 (5) In the case of an initial financing statement or an amendment 9 that provides a name of a debtor which was not previously provided in 10 the financing statement to which the amendment relates, the record does 11 not:
- 12 (A) Provide a mailing address for the debtor;
- 13 (B) Indicate whether the debtor is an individual or an 14 organization; or
- 15 (C) If the financing statement indicates that the debtor is an 16 organization, provide:
  - (i) A type of organization for the debtor;

- 29 (1) A record does not provide information if the filing office is 30 unable to read or decipher the information; and
- (2) A record that does not indicate that it is an amendment or identify an initial financing statement to which it relates, as required by RCW 62A.9A-512, 62A.9A-514, or 62A.9A-518, is an initial financing statement.
- 35 (d) Refusal to accept record; record effective as filed record. A
  36 record that is communicated to the filing office with tender of the
  37 filing fee, but which the filing office refuses to accept for a reason
  38 other than one set forth in subsection (b) of this section, is
  39 effective as a filed record except as against a purchaser of the

- 1 collateral which gives value in reasonable reliance upon the absence of
- 2 the record from the files.

- 5 ACCEPTANCE AND REFUSAL TO ACCEPT RECORD. (a) Mandatory refusal to

- 35 extrinsic evidence of its authenticity.
