5 On page 13, after line 13, insert the following:

6 "Sec. 27. RCW 29.42.070 and 1991 c 363 s 35 are each amended to  
7 read as follows:

8 Within forty-five days after the state-wide general election in  
9 even-numbered years, or within thirty days following July 30, 1967, for  
10 the biennium ending with the 1968 general elections, the county chair  
11 of each major political party shall call separate meetings of all  
12 elected precinct committee officers in each legislative district ((a  
13 majority of the precincts of which are within a county with a  
14 population of one million or more)) for the purpose of electing a  
15 legislative district chair in such district. The district chair shall  
16 hold office until the next legislative district reorganizational  
17 meeting two years later, or until a successor is elected.

18 The legislative district chair can only be removed by the majority  
19 vote of the elected precinct committee officers in the chair's  
20 district."

21 Renumber the sections consecutively and correct any internal  
22 references accordingly.

**EFFECT:** Requires all county chairs of major political parties to call meetings of elected precinct committee officers in each legislative district in order to elect a legislative district chair. Currently, this requirement only applies to counties with

populations of one million or more.
