Brief Description: Changing provisions regarding technology fees at institutions of higher education.

Brief Summary of Bill

- · Adds community and technical colleges to statute.
- · Asks for a state dollar-for-dollar match of technology fees collected.
- · Requires 3.5 percent of the match be deposited in the institution's local financial aid fund.

Background:

Summary of Bill:

The public community and technical colleges are included in the statute allowing governing boards, with written agreement of the student governance, to establish a student technology fee.

Following one year of collection and expenditure of the technology fee, institutions are

eligible for a state match on a dollar-for-dollar basis to a maximum of \$450,000 per year, per campus.

Of any state match, 3.5 percent must be deposited in the institution's local financial aid fund.

Effective Date: Ninety days after adjournment of session in which bill is passed.

Appropriation: None.
