Synopsis as Enacted

Brief Description: Authorizing all counties to share county road engineering services.

Sponsors: By Representatives Schoesler, Cox, Eickmeyer, Ahern, Chandler, Mulliken and Haigh.

House Committee on Local Government & Housing Senate Committee on State & Local Government

Background:

The legislative authority of each county with a population of 8,000 or more must employ a full-time county road engineer. The legislative authority of each other county must employ an engineer either on a full-time or part-time basis or may contract with another county for the engineering services of a road engineer from such other county.

Summary:

The requirement that each county with a population of 8,000 or more employ a full-time road engineer is eliminated. These counties must hire either a full-time or part-time road engineer or may contract with another county for engineering services.
