**Background:** In the sale of real estate, Washington law provides for the seller to disclose on a form certain conditions of the real estate. The disclosure form does not specifically provide for the disclosure of water infiltration through floors or walls.

**Summary of Bill:** Specific disclosure of water infiltration through walls and floors of a home and if the infiltration repairs have been made is provided for in the disclosure form.
