**Background:** "Shared games" are games such as Powerball in which several states join together to offer a lottery game. 21 states currently participate in Powerball through the multi-state lottery association, and seven states currently participate in "The Big Game," another multi-state lottery game.

Current law requires that the Lottery Commission receive permission from the Legislature prior to entering into any agreement with other states to conduct shared games.

**Summary of Bill:** The Lottery Commission is authorized to take actions necessary to participate with other state lotteries in shared games.

**Appropriation:** None.

**Fiscal Note:** Available.

**Effective Date:** Ninety days after adjournment of session in which bill is passed.
