**Title:** An act relating to permits for a conditional use or variance issued by local governments under approved master programs pursuant to the shoreline management act.

**Brief Description:** Eliminating the authority of the department of ecology to impose conditions on conditional use or variance permits issued under the shoreline management act.

**Background:** The Department of Ecology can establish conditions on conditional use and variances issued by local governments under the Shoreline Management Act.

**Summary of Bill:** The authority of the Department of Ecology to impose conditions on conditional use or various permits issued by local governments under the Shoreline Management Act is eliminated.

**Appropriation:** None.

**Fiscal Note:** Requested on February 1, 2002.

**Effective Date:** The bill contains an emergency clause and takes effect May 1, 2002.
