1 AN ACT Relating to product standards; and amending RCW 2 43.19A.020.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4 Sec. 1. RCW 43.19A.020 and 1996 c 198 s 1 are each amended to read 5 as follows:

6 (1) The ((USEPA)) <u>federal</u> product standards, ((as now or hereafter amended)) adopted under 42 U.S.C. Sec. 6962(e) as it 7 exists on the effective date of this act, are adopted as the 8 minimum standards for the state of Washington. These standards 9 10 shall be implemented for at least the products listed in ((a) and(b) of)) this subsection ((by the dates indicated)), unless the 11 director finds that a different standard would significantly 12 13 increase recycled product availability or competition. 14 (a) ((By July 1, 1997: 15 (i)) Paper and paper products; ((((ii))) (b) Organic recovered materials; ((and 16

- 17 (iii))) (c) Latex paint products;
- 18 (((b) By July 1, 1997:

1 (i)) (d) Products for lower value uses containing recycled
2 plastics;

3 ((((ii)))) (<u>e</u>) Retread and remanufactured tires;

4 (((iii))) <u>(f)</u> Lubricating oils;

5 ((((iv))) (<u>(g)</u> Automotive batteries;

6 (((v))) (<u>h</u>) Building ((insulation)) products and materials;

7 (((vi))) <u>(i)</u> Panelboard; and

8 ((((vii)))) <u>(j)</u> Compost products.

9 (2) By July 1, 2002, the director shall adopt product standards 10 for strawboard manufactured using as an ingredient straw that is 11 produced as a by-product in the production of cereal grain or turf 12 or grass seed and product standards for products made from 13 strawboard.

14 (3) The standards required by this section shall be applied to 15 recycled product purchasing by the department ((and)), other state agencies, and state postsecondary educational institutions. 16 The standards may be adopted or applied by any other local government 17 in product procurement. The standards shall provide for exceptions 18 19 under appropriate circumstances to allow purchases of recycled 20 products that do not meet the minimum content requirements of the standards. 21
