1 AN ACT Relating to real estate appraisers; and amending RCW 2 18.140.155.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 18.140.155 and 1993 c 30 s 16 are each amended to read 5 as follows:

6 (1) A real estate appraiser from another state who is licensed or 7 certified by another state may apply for registration to receive 8 temporary licensing or certification in Washington by paying a fee and 9 filing a notarized application with the department on a form provided 10 by the department.

(2) The director is authorized to adopt by rule the term or 11 duration of the licensing and certification privileges granted under 12 13 the provisions of this section ((shall expire ninety days from 14 Licensing or certification shall not be renewed((, nor issuance)). 15 shall an applicant receive more than two registrations within any twelve-month period)). However, an applicant may receive an extension 16 17 of a temporary practice permit to complete an assignment, provided that a written request is received by the department prior to the expiration 18 date, stating the reason for the extension. 19

(3) <u>A temporary practice permit issued under this section allows an</u>
<u>appraiser to perform independent appraisal services required by a</u>
<u>contract for appraisal services.</u>

4 <u>(4)</u> Persons granted temporary licensing or certification privileges 5 under this section shall not advertise or otherwise hold themselves out 6 as being licensed or certified by the state of Washington.

7 (((4))) <u>(5)</u> Persons granted temporary licensure or certification 8 are subject to all provisions under this chapter.
