- 1 AN ACT Relating to identification of students at institutions of
- 2 higher education; adding a new section to chapter 28B.10 RCW; and
- 3 creating new sections.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 5 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** The legislature finds that the occurrences
- 6 of identity theft are increasing. The legislature also finds that
- 7 widespread use of the federally issued social security numbers has made
- 8 identity theft more likely to occur.
- 9 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 2.** A new section is added to chapter 28B.10 RCW
- 10 to read as follows:
- 11 (1) Institutions of higher education shall not use students' social
- 12 security numbers for identification, except for the purposes of
- 13 employment and financial aid or as otherwise required by state or
- 14 federal law.
- 15 (2) Each institution of higher education shall develop a system of
- 16 personal identifiers for students to be used for grading and other
- 17 administrative purposes. The personal identifiers may not be social
- 18 security numbers.

NEW SECTION. **Sec. 3.** The institutions of higher education, in conjunction with the higher education coordinating board and the state board for community and technical colleges, shall submit a report to the legislature by December 1, 2001, outlining the institution's personal identifier system.
