- 1 AN ACT Relating to appeal provisions for boarding homes; adding
- 2 a new section to chapter 18.20 RCW; and declaring an emergency.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 NEW SECTION. Sec. 1. A new section is added to chapter 18.20
- 5 RCW to read as follows:
- A licensee has the right to contest, under chapter 34.05 RCW
- 7 and the informal dispute resolution process made available to
- 8 boarding homes, any department finding of noncompliance with any
- 9 laws and rules that govern boarding homes, regardless of whether
- 10 the department takes action against the licensee.
- 11 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 2.** This act is necessary for the immediate
- 12 preservation of the public peace, health, or safety, or support of
- 13 the state government and its existing public institutions, and
- 14 takes effect immediately.
