- 1 AN ACT Relating to election procedures for park and recreation
- 2 district commissioners; and amending RCW 36.69.090.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 36.69.090 and 1996 c 324 s 2 are each amended to read 5 as follows:
- A park and recreation district shall be governed by a board of five commissioners. Except for the initial commissioners, all commissioners shall be elected to staggered four-year terms of office and shall serve until their successors are elected and qualified and assume office in accordance with RCW 29.04.170. Candidates shall run for specific commissioner positions.
- Elections for park and recreation district commissioners shall be held biennially in conjunction with the general election in each odd-numbered year. Elections shall be held in accordance with the provisions of Title 29 RCW dealing with general elections((, except
- 16 that there shall be no primary to nominate candidates)). All persons
- 17 filing and qualifying shall appear on the general election ballot and

- 1 the person receiving the largest number of votes for each position
- 2 shall be elected.
