1 AN ACT Relating to authorizing bona fide charitable and nonprofit 2 organizations to conduct electronic bingo; and amending RCW 9.46.0205.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 9.46.0205 and 1987 c 4 s 3 are each amended to read as 5 follows:

6 (1) "Bingo," as used in this chapter, means a game conducted only 7 in the county within which the organization is principally located in which prizes are awarded on the basis of designated numbers or symbols 8 9 on a card conforming to numbers or symbols selected at random and in 10 which no cards are sold except at the time and place of said game, when said game is conducted by a bona fide charitable or nonprofit 11 organization which does not conduct or allow its premises to be used 12 13 for conducting bingo on more than three occasions per week and which 14 does not conduct bingo in any location which is used for conducting 15 bingo on more than three occasions per week, or if an agricultural fair authorized under chapters 15.76 and 36.37 RCW, which does not conduct 16 17 bingo on more than twelve consecutive days in any calendar year, and except in the case of any agricultural fair as authorized under 18 chapters 15.76 and 36.37 RCW, no person other than a bona fide member 19

or an employee of said organization takes any part in the management or 1 operation of said game, and no person who takes any part in the 2 management or operation of said game takes any part in the management 3 4 or operation of any game conducted by any other organization or any other branch of the same organization, unless approved by the 5 commission, and no part of the proceeds thereof inure to the benefit of 6 7 any person other than the organization conducting said game. For the 8 purposes of this section, the organization shall be deemed to be 9 principally located in the county within which it has its primary 10 business office. If the organization has no business office, the organization shall be deemed to be located in the county of principal 11 residence of its chief executive officer: 12 PROVIDED, That any organization which is conducting any licensed and established bingo 13 game in any locale as of January 1, 1981, shall be exempt from the 14 15 requirement that such game be conducted in the county in which the 16 organization is principally located.

(2) "Bingo" includes games conducted through an approved system of 17 18 linked electronic bingo terminals located at one or more licensed bingo 19 locations with the numbers or symbols selected at a single licensed bingo location for all terminals on the system. The commission shall 20 adopt rules for the testing, regulation, approval, and licensing of 21 bingo games conducted through any system of linked electronic bingo 22 terminals. Licensees are limited to no more than two hundred linked 23 24 bingo terminals per location. Notwithstanding subsection (1) of this section, bona fide charitable or nonprofit organizations may allow 25 26 their premises to be used seven days per week to conduct bingo games using linked electronic bingo terminals. Linked electronic bingo 27 terminals shall not include stand-alone gambling devices. 28

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
