- 1 AN ACT Relating to the sale of wine for off-premises consumption;
- 2 and adding a new section to chapter 66.24 RCW.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 66.24 RCW 5 to read as follows:
- 6 Upon payment of an annual fee of one hundred twenty dollars to the
- 7 liquor control board, the holder of a spirits, beer, and wine
- 8 restaurant license, and the holder of a spirits, beer, and wine private
- 9 club license, is allowed to sell for off-premises consumption: (1)
- 10 Wine vinted and bottled in the state of Washington and carrying a label
- 11 exclusive to the license holder selling the wine; and (2) sparkling
- 12 wine from California bottled exclusively for the license holder selling
- 13 the sparkling wine. Spirits and beer may not be sold for off-premises
- 14 consumption under this section.
