1 AN ACT Relating to suspension, revocation, and denial of driver 2 training school instructor licenses; and amending RCW 46.82.350.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4 **sec. 1.** RCW 46.82.350 and 1979 ex.s. c 51 s 8 are each amended to 5 read as follows:

6 (1) The director may suspend, revoke, deny, or refuse to renew an 7 instructor's license or a driver training school license for any of the 8 following causes:

9 (a) Upon determination that the licensee has made a false statement 10 or concealed any material fact in connection with the application or 11 license renewal;

(b) Upon ((conviction of)) determination that the applicant, licensee, or any person directly or indirectly interested in the driver training school's business <u>has been convicted</u> of a felony, or any crime involving violence, dishonesty, deceit, indecency, degeneracy, or moral turpitude;

(c) Upon determination that the applicant, licensee, or any persondirectly or indirectly interested in the driver training school's

1 business previously held a driver training school license which was 2 revoked, suspended, or refused renewal by the director;

3 (d) Upon determination that the applicant or licensee does not have4 a place of business as required by this chapter;

5 (e) Upon determination that the applicant or licensee has failed to 6 require all persons with financial interest in the driver training 7 school to be signatories to the application;

8 (f) Upon determination that the applicant or licensee has been 9 found guilty of fraud or fraudulent practices in relation to the 10 business conducted under the license, or guilty of inducing another to 11 resort to fraud in relation to securing for himself, herself, or 12 another a license to drive a motor vehicle; or

(g) Upon determination that the applicant or licensee fails to satisfy <u>or no longer meets</u> the <u>requirements for taking a license</u> <u>examination, issuance of a license, or</u> other conditions stated in this chapter.
